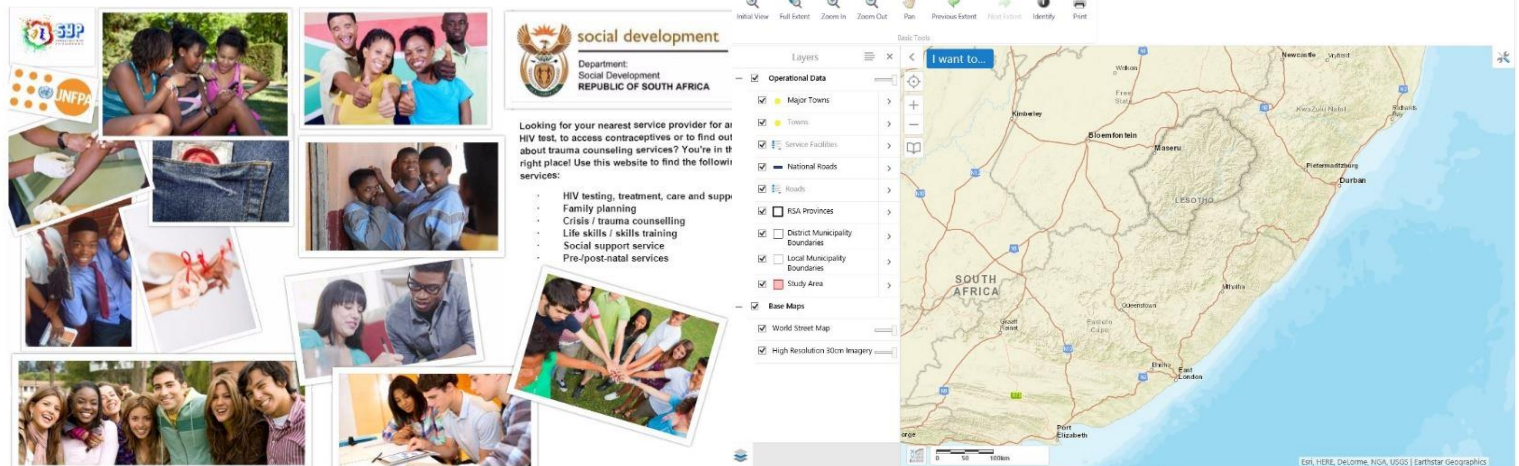

UNFPA South African Safeguard Young People GIS

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GeoAfrika Technologies was appointed by the United Nations Population Fund (UNFPA) to map of all adolescent sexual and reproductive health and HIV service delivery points and providers, and to provide a user-friendly Geographic Information Systems (GIS) database that could be used to interrogate this data. These points needed to be mapped within the eight UNFPA supported priority District Municipalities in the Eastern Cape and Kwazulu Natal: Ugu, Zululand, Uthukela, Umkhanyakude, Ilembe, Alfred Nzo, Amathole and OR Tambo.

The project formed part of a larger six year, two-phased regional initiative entitled "Safeguard Young People in Southern Africa Programme" (SYP). The regional programme is being implemented in eight Southern African countries (Botswana, Lesotho, Malawi, South Africa, Namibia, Swaziland, Zambia and Zimbabwe) and is coordinated by the United Nations Population Fund (UNFPA) regional office East and Southern Africa.

Scope of Work

- Source data from government departments and the private sector.
- Develop a geocoded service provider database using the consolidated data acquired.
- Verify data through a desktop survey using the latest available aerial photography.
- Serve data via geocortex for view and query on any device (PC, laptop, tablet, smartphone)
- Produce digital and hardcopy maps for stakeholders.
- Produce a user manual on data, tools and functionality.
